St. Paul on the Lake Marriage Preparation Program

“Marriage is a Gift” is a comprehensive and interactive immersion into the Catholic Church’s vision for the Sacrament of Matrimony as a lifelong commitment of total and self-giving love. This two-day, 12-hour program is developed for engaged couples preparing to marry in the Catholic Church at St. Paul on the Lake.

“Marriage is a Gift” covers the following:

- The Catholic Church’s vision of the true meaning of marriage (which includes the Scriptural basis for marriage, the graces of a Sacramental marriage, and the covenantal nature of marriage).
- A practical overview of the blessings and challenges of marriage (which includes communication, conflict resolution, and protecting the marriage bond).
- Overview and resources on Natural Family Planning
