



Confirmation Name 2022

Your name gives you an identity; it tells others who you are. When you were baptized, your parents chose your name. Do you know your parents' reasons for choosing your name? If not, ask them about it.

When you are presented to the Bishop for Confirmation, the Bishop will ask you to state your Confirmation name. You are encouraged to use your baptismal name as your Confirmation name because Confirmation is actually the completion of the Sacrament of Baptism. However, the candidate remains free to select another Christian name. If you choose a Confirmation name other than your baptismal name, that name should be the name of a saint whom you admire or have a devotion to. You should pray to this saint for guidance and help in living the Christian life. Check the following websites for more information about the saints:
